Sam Houston State University – The Woodlands Center was the venue for the July Business After Hours. The event was co-hosted by the SHSU Alumni Association and Athletic Department.

Enrollment has steadily increased over the past several years with a record-setting 19,214 students in the Fall 2013 semester. SHSU is the 12th largest university in the state.

SHSU ranks 4th of 38 public Texas universities for graduates obtaining employment within 12 months of receiving their bachelor's degrees, according to The Texas Higher Education 2013 Almanac.

The nursing program will begin offering the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree, leading to licensure at SHSU-The Woodlands Center in 2015.

Bearkat teams have made 25 NCAA Division 1 post-season appearances, including back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Division I Football National Championship Game. The athletic program has received the Southland Commissioner's Cup All-Sports Trophy in 2005, 2006, 2007, 2013 and 2014—the most for any university in the conference.
